COMPETITION ITEMS 2024

The matching pepper and salt mills for the Swan WEW in April is the first item we will attempt. Aiton, Tania, Don, Ross and Syd will participate. We also agreed to do the Hollow form for the Mandurah competition in May. Aiton, Tania, Noel and Jon will participate.

DUMMY SHELL PROJECT

Specifications for Rottnest Island's Dummy shells have been sent in by Noel and circulated. There was much discussion how we will prepare for this. Noel and Ross calculated the dimensions and amounts of timber needed and the likely costs involved. Noel emphasized the importance of the barrel section being accurately turned with parallel sides. He made a mock blank using staves which he still needs to finish but he is concerned that it may be too thin. He had difficulty gluing the staves together. The projectile is tapered to a 1402mm radius. A template to help shape it will be useful. The projectile may be made up of segmented rings. Noel had prepared a cutting list which Aiton will circulate with these notes. The base plate will be a solid piece of timber with the necessary spigots which Noel illustrated on the whiteboard.
