DUMMY SHELL PROJECT

Specifications and the cutting list for Rottnest Island's Dummy shells have been sent in by Noel and circulated. Syd has made up a1402mm radius template for shaping the projectile which will be constructed from segmented rings. Assembling and finishing the project will be done at our meetings.

Aiton has had difficulties with the dimensions in the cutting lists for the projectile rings. He has made up one projectile which is only roughly shaped. Syd took it to rescue and finish.

Ring dimensions will be re-visited. Noel is asked to prepare a new cutting list with rings 2-10 in 24 segments and rings 11 onwards in 12 segments.
