DUMMY SHELL PROJECT

Photos at the end of these notes show Syd & Tania admiring the staved shell casings and Ian assembling the projectile rings. The division of labour was discussed on who is to do what. The following is noted:-

- TREV will cut and assemble rings 2-8 – 12 segments each, 35mm wide and 31mm high.
- SYD will continue making up centres for inserts to fasten to face plates for shaping projectiles once rings are assembled.
- AITON will continue making up rings #9-12 – 12 segments each, 35 wide and 31 high.

3. WAWA competition items.

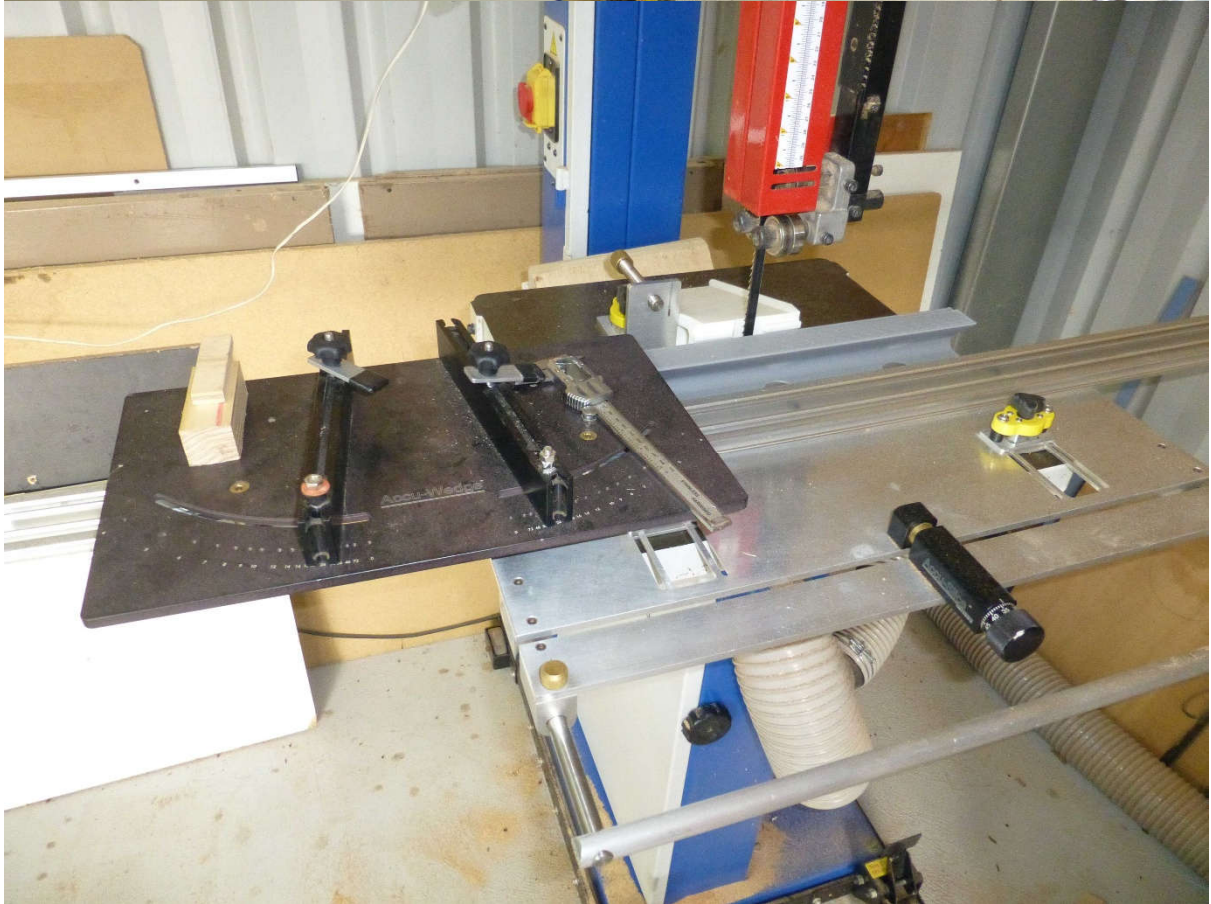
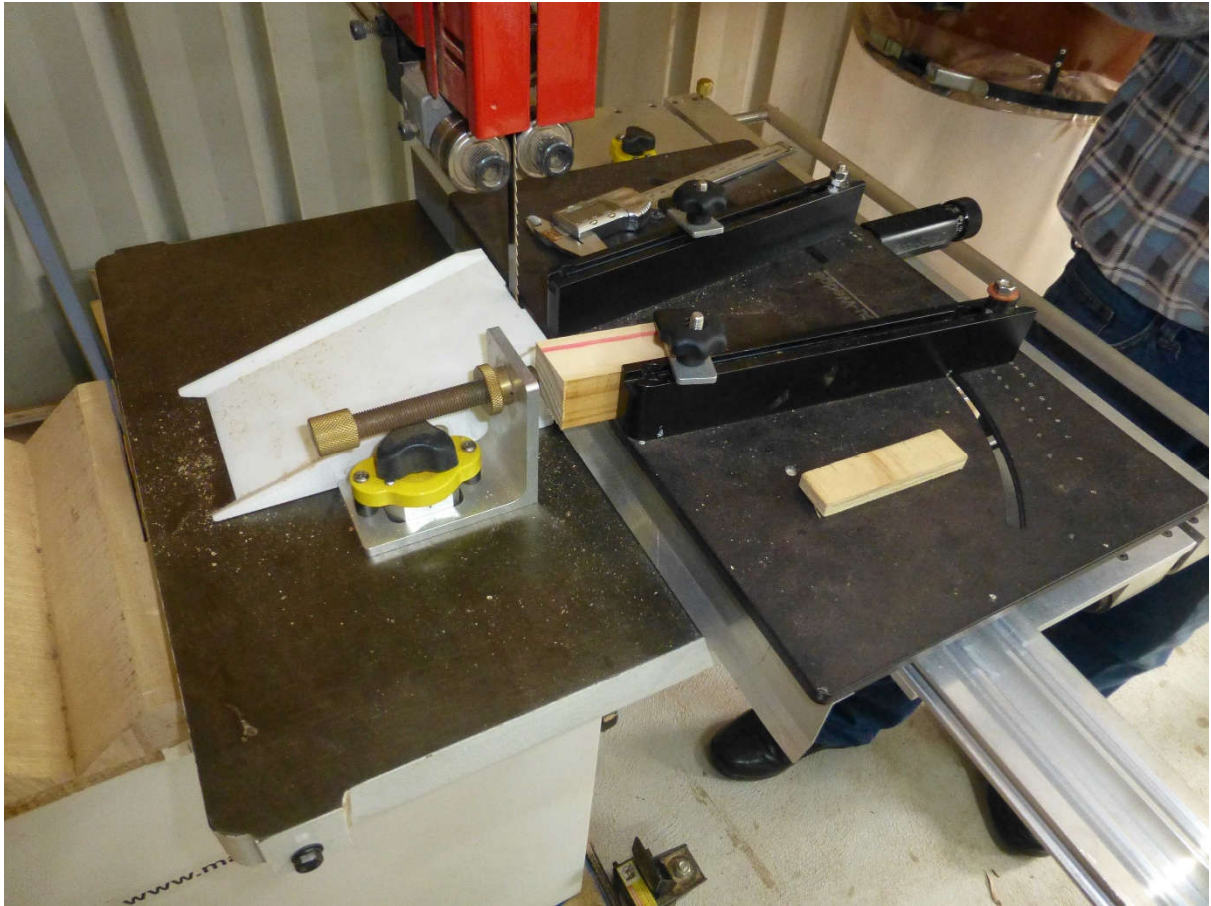
AROUND THE TABLE
