CRAFT ALIVE FAIR

WAWA is co-ordinating woodturning side of the Craft Alive Fair from August 1-4. The Seggies will be involved and it may be possible for a drop or bandsaw to be there for cutting segments. Space may be limited so we may have to confine ourselves to a display of what can be done in segmenting rather than demonstrating. Importantly volunteers will be needed over the four days from the WAWA membership as a whole.

DUMMY SHELL PROJECT

Timber is being cut for 10 dummy shells for the Rottnest Island Board

- TREV is cutting rings 2-8 – 12 segments each, 35mm wide and 31mm high. Syd has also done some and will let Trev know how many more sets are required.
- SYD will continue making up centres for inserts to fasten to face plates for shaping projectiles once rings are assembled.
- AITON had made 6 sets of rings #9-12 – 12 segments each, 35 wide and 31 high. There are enough sets for the projectile apart from another ring #9 (Aiton has 3 made up) and will make another six rings #13
