## **TRAINING**

Although the basic bowl training course is completed, Don Clarke will be teaching us how to construct a feature ring with the Greek key design when he is available for a Sunday meeting.

## AROUND THE TABLE

KERRY – brought in the strip of laminated timber that she made up to cut for her feature ring. Syd explained the inaccuracies she had because the timber had not been precisely dressed before laminating. He also stressed the importance of accurate cutting the segments.

IAN – explained how Jarrah and Meranti can be distinguished by the way they burn. Jarrah burns black and Meranti burns white.

DAVID – explained the faults in his training bowl because of the build up of adhesive on the trailing edge of the chisel bevel. This effected the cut.

GEOFF – recommended 'Papa 1947' on YouTube which had good stuff on segmenting and feature ring designs. He explained how he uses John DiStefano's online program for designing. He then transfers the details to AutoCad where he plays around with the details. He believes resin takes segmenting to a higher level and that resin courses are run on Thursday afternoons.
