SEGMENTED MOB MEETING NOTES MELVILLE CLUBROOMS Thursday 29 May, 2025


Present – Syd Harvey, Aiton Sheppard, Mike Phillips, Geoff Stayplton, Ian Hamilton and Ray Dallin.

AROUND THE TABLE

AITON – brought in Sheoak rings for his Collie WEW competition fruit bowl. The base should be increased from 60 to 80 mm if the convex shape is to be successful. Otherwise' he will try a concave bottom and do an ogee shape. Aiton is still to contact Tony Taverner in Kingsley to see if he has any shelving or planks left to give away. Geoff in interested and will accompany Aiton if a plan is made to collect timber for seggies.



MIKE – said he should have brought in examples of the laminating work he had at home and in which members may be interested. He will bring these to our next meeting.

RAY – asked for more demos to be done to show people how to do things they were having trouble with. It was sussested that these should be hands-on for members to also try and do what they were seeing at meetings.

GEOFF – explained the difficulty he was having with a laminated segment he wanted to insert into a segmented ring. The rings have to

be flat and carefully sanded to ensure the diagonal corners of the insert were not removed. It was suggested that the height/thickness of the insert be made slightly less than the other ring segments and then the ring turned down to the level of the insert.
